In an eight-round junior middleweight bout, Alantez Fox (18-0-1, 7 KO's) of Forestville, MD will take on Josue Obando (14-9-1, 11 KO's) of Guadalajara. Mexico.

Billel Dib (18-1, 9 KO's) of Sydney, Australia will make his much anticipated American debut when he takes on Jose Salinas (9-1-1, 5 KO's) of Albuquerque, New Mexico in a lightweight bout scheduled for eight-rounds.
