

Teenage Phenom Milton Santiago Jr. to be honored by High School board tonight

Warminster, PA (MAY 13, 2014)—TONIGHT, next to the William Tennent High School, undefeated Jr. Welterweight Milton Santiago will receive a special honor by the school board for his professional boxing career.
